MERSEBURG - Residence town

Since the earliest Middle Ages Merseburg on the river Saale, hometown of the "Merseburg Incantations" (Merseburger Zaubersprüche), was the residency of a bishopric as well as of the dukedom Saxony-Merseburg plus the center of power of the Prussian province of Saxony.

The cathedral district with the architectural unique ensemble consisting of cathedral, chapterhouse, castle, castle garden and estates assembly building stands without any comparison in the region of Central Germany. Because of its excellent interior with medieval and new-age artworks, the Cathedral of St. John and Lawrence is one of the most meaningful sights on the touristic route "Romanesque Road" (Straße der Romanik). As well it keeps the famous Merseburg Incantations, the oldest known papers in Old High German of Germanic pagan belief.

Due to the common legend of the raven the animal became the mascot of the today's district town.

Venerable curiae which house art and event gastronomy, pretty town houses as well as broad parks give the former bishopric and dukedom its distinct atmosphere.

The cultural offer is diversified and multifaceted. Highlights are the annual castle festival (Merseburger Schlossfest) with its historic pageant in the beginning of June and the organ festival (Merseburger Orgeltage) in the middle of September, the biggest sacred music festival in Saxony-
