Veißentels - Residence town

Largest town between Merseburg and Naumburg. Weißenfels was founded in 1185 and protected by a castle on a white rock, hence the name. The early-Barogue-style castle Neu-Augustusburg was built on the site of the old medieval castle in the second half of the 17th century. Situated on the river Saale, Weißenfels is full of history and has seen many well-known master builders and artists within its walls.
